

In response to Coronavirus and in support of the Palm Island Community, SeaLink will provide an unaccompanied freight service for **ESSENTIAL HOUSEHOLD SUPPLIES**

This freight service will only operate whilst travel restrictions are in place.

**Conditions of unaccompanied freight:**

- **Essential items only (food, medical, cleaning, personal items). Note there is limited cold storage available, as per our normal freight processes**
- Limit of 4 items per person
- All food items must be sealed/wrapped so that no chemicals can enter these goods (SeaLink will be chemically treating all freight items for COVID 19)
- All items must be clearly labelled with the name of the person collecting the item
- There will be no cost for these freight items
- Freight will still be subject to the usual inspections under the Alcohol Management Plan

Freight items will be strictly managed. Essential items **DO NOT** include electrical appliances or furniture including TV's, bikes, stereos, mowers etc.

**Palm Island Freight Policy:**

- All freight must be checked in at the freight counter as individual items as per our usual freight policy
- SeaLink reserves the right to refuse to carry freight that does not comply with our Freight Policy or Dangerous Goods Code and the vessel Master has the final decision
- SeaLink takes no responsibility for any loss or damage to freight
- No alcohol is permitted in the Freight Trolleys

**No commercial freight will be accepted during this time.**

Trolleys are available to book for \$60 (these are limited, and you must call the office ahead of time to book)

**SeaLink accepts no responsibility for unclaimed items, someone must be available at Palm Island to meet the freight as items will be left on the jetty at your own risk.**
